

On-line Professional Development Opportunities



Below you will find a list of FREE, on-line, professional development trainings that early learning educators and administrators can access to support with their required 21 hours of PD for QSLA. All trainings are either recorded directly in the CA ECE Workforce Registry or provide certificates that can be submitted to the Registry to count towards PD hours.

California Early Childhood Online (CECO) - The California Department of Education (CDE) has an Online Learning Portal that provides access to over 80 hours of self-paced training on a variety of early childhood related topics.
