

Enrollment Selection Criteria for Non-CSPP Centers and FCCs

Quality Start Los Angeles (QSLA) used available data to identify high priority communities in Los Angeles County where its enrollment efforts will be focused to ensure equity and access to services within the early learning system. Family Child Care Homes (FCCs) and center-based programs that do not receive funding from the California State Preschool Program (CSPP) that apply to QSLA will receive one point for each priority criteria they meet. Sites with the most points will receive priority enrollment. Once available spots are filled by applicants with the highest points, all other applicants will be put on the waitlist until the next open enrollment period, based on funding.
