

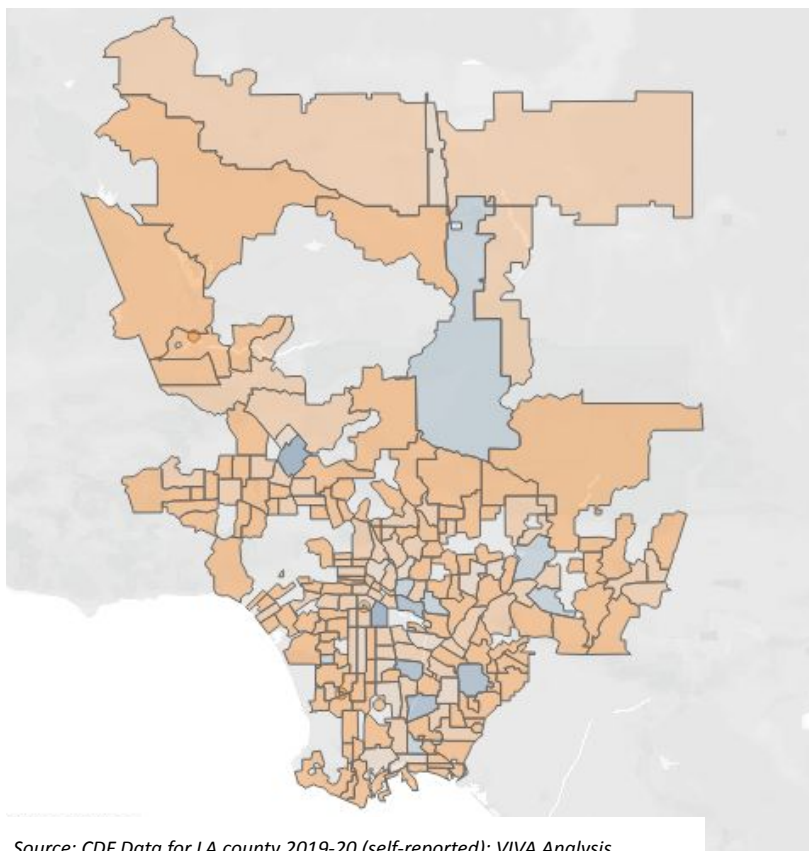
# Demographic snapshot of providers and children FY 2019-2020



Quality Start Los Angeles (QSLA) is a county-wide system that nurtures the whole child, strengthens families, and elevates excellence in early learning programs. We believe all children should have access to high-impact learning environments, which is the quality foundation they need for future learning and life. We partner with early learning programs to support families and improve early learning program quality.

Despite challenges brought on by the pandemic, Family Child Care providers (FCCs) and Center-based providers continued to serve children and families across Los Angeles County. As of October 2020, 22% of QSLA Centers and 91% of FCCs stayed open to serve children in person during the peak of the COVID-19 pandemic. In addition, 58% of QSLA Centers and 1% of FCCs who stayed open offered virtual services.\*

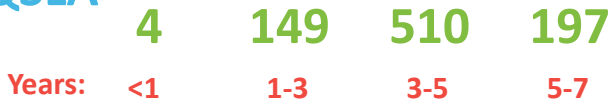

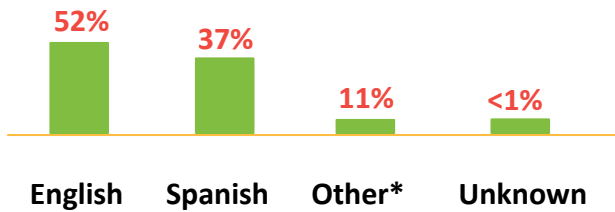
## Providers enrolled in QSLA by tier



## Providers by years enrolled in QSLA

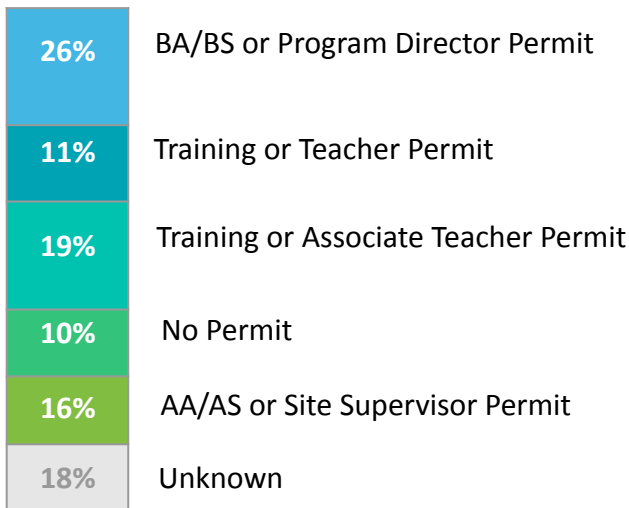

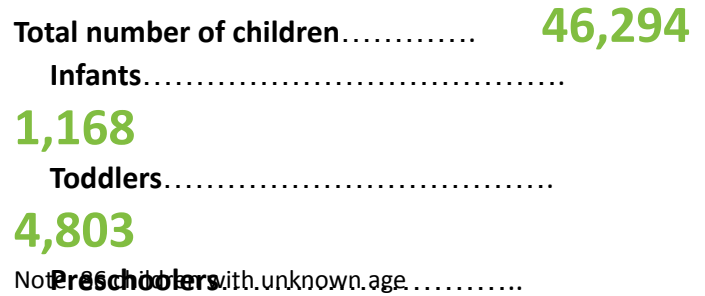
## Education level attained



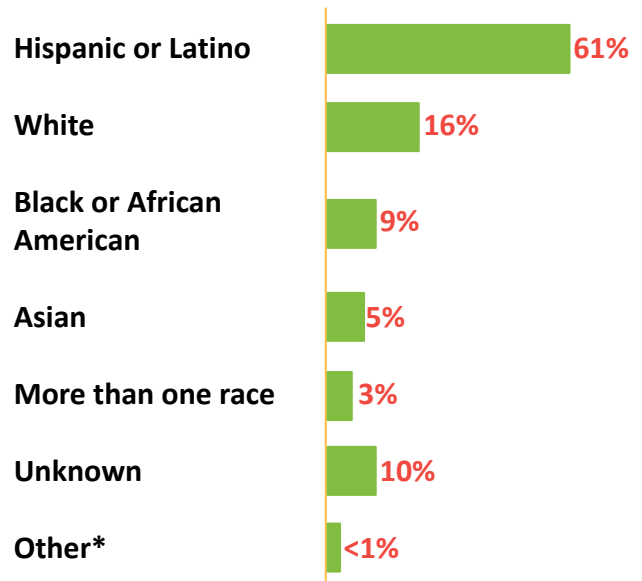

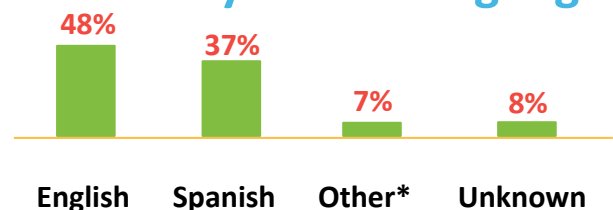


## Children by race
