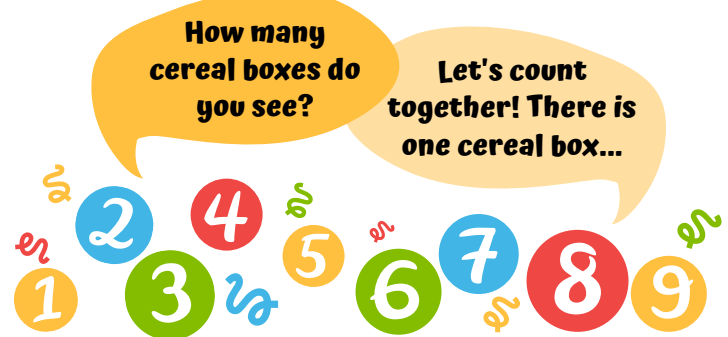
## Monthly Activity
