Pumpkin Math Activity Guide

This Thanksgiving number recognition activity is a fun way to work on number sense while making a fall-themed craft. You can also use the pie for pretend play!



Step 1: Draw a crust on the outer edges of your paper plate using a brown marker or crayon.

Step 2: Help your little one cut the orange paper into a circle matching the size of the plate. Then divide the plate into 6 pie pieces with a marker.

Step 3: Then, number each piece from 1 to 6.

Step 4: Help your child add a corresponding number of whip cream dollops (cotton balls/white paper) or pumpkin seeds to each piece as shown on the first, second and fourth slice.

Step 5: Children will count the number aloud when they put the whip cream on top of each piece.
