Holi Spring Tree

1. Help your little one cut a tree shape out of brown paper. Alternatively, you can draw a tree onto your paper using brown markers or colored pencils.
2. Glue your tree to a white piece of paper.
3. Tear small pieces of multi-colored tissue paper. Scrunch up the tissue paper into small balls.
4. Glue down your tissue paper balls onto the branches to make a colorful tree!
