ST. PATRICK'S DAY ACTIVITIES

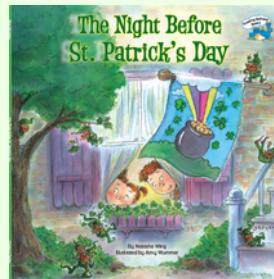
Are you and your little ones hoping to find the pot of gold at the end of the rainbow this St. Patrick's Day? Check out these hands-on activities and maybe you'll spot a leprechaun!



- **Gold Coins:** Using yellow play dough (sprinkled with gold glitter), have your little ones cut out "gold coins" using different size bottle caps and lids. Have them count each of their coins.
- **Leprechaun Hat:** Using green paper, cut a band that fits around your little one's head and large and small rectangles. Attach the rectangles to the front of the band to form a top hat. Have your little one cut out a black strip of paper for the hat band. Sprinkle with glitter or add other St. Patrick's Day decorations. Enjoy imaginary leprechaun play!
- **Leprechaun Wish:** Ask your child what he/she would wish for if they caught a leprechaun and could have one wish? Have your child draw a picture of what they would wish for.
