Paper Bag Dragon Activity

Step 1



1. Help your little one cut a tongue from red paper. Then, cut 2 long rectangles from green construction paper and 2 ovals for eyes.

Step 2



2. Use the bottom of the bag for the face of the dragon. Glue your pieces down to the flap on your paper bag, as shown on the left.

Step 3



3. Cut the opening of the paper bag to create flaps. Color your dragon any way you want!
